From Father:

This Sunday the Church in the United States pauses to honor the beautiful work of catechesis—the handing on of the Faith, the depositum fidei, from one generation to the next. St. Paul puts it simply: tradidi quod et accepi—"I handed on to you what I also received." That is the heart of catechesis. We do not invent the Gospel; we receive it, live it, and pass it on by word and example.

Today I want to express heartfelt gratitude to those who labor so faithfully in this mission here at Epiphany. Thank you to all our catechists in the PREP (Parish Religious Education Program), and in a special way to Mrs. Linda DiCampli, who works so hard to make our PREP program successful. Your preparation, prayer, and personal witness form our children in the truths that lead to life. I also wish to thank Mrs. Fran Luthy, our school principal, and all the dedicated teachers of Holy Rosary Regional Catholic School. Day after day you unite learning with faith, helping our young people to love what is true, good, and beautiful. Please know of my prayers and the parish's deep appreciation.

The Church has always taught that parents are the first and best teachers of the faith. Our homes are meant to be "little churches," where children first learn to make the Sign of the Cross, to speak to God, to forgive, and to serve. PREP and Holy Rosary assist this sacred task, but they can never replace the grace of a mother's prayer, a father's blessing, and a family's fidelity to Sunday Mass. Children may not remember every lesson we speak, but they rarely forget how we live. As the old maxim reminds us: lex orandi, lex credendi—how we pray shapes what we believe.

How, then, do we all—parents, grandparents, godparents, and parishioners—carry this work forward?

- *Be faithful to Sunday Mass and Confession. Nothing teaches like joyful fidelity.*
- *Pray daily as a family. A simple Morning Offering, grace before meals, and a Hail Mary at night form sturdy hearts.*
- *Keep a Catholic home. Enthrona a crucifix, read the Scriptures, and celebrate the feasts of the Church year.*
- *Teach mercy. Let children see forgiveness practiced—at home, in school, and on the playground.*
- *Serve together. Works of mercy make doctrine visible and Christ credible.*

To our catechists and teachers: your vocation is noble and needed. Thank you for preparing lessons, arriving early, staying late, and—above all—for witnessing to Christ with your lives. To our parents and families: thank you for the sacrifices you make to raise your children in the Faith. To all parishioners: please keep our catechists, students, and school in your daily prayers; consider volunteering where you can, and always encourage our young people to love Jesus in the Eucharist.

May Mary, Seat of Wisdom, guide our efforts; may St. Joseph protect our families; and may St. Charles Borromeo, patron of catechists, obtain for us zeal and perseverance. Together, by God's grace, may we hand on to our children a living faith—whole, joyful, and unapologetically Catholic.

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month. Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
