From Father:

This week our parish keeps a beautiful and time-honored devotion: Forty Hours. Each evening—Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday at 7:00 PM—we will gather before Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament, with Archbishop Adams preaching. On Tuesday night, we will hold a Eucharistic procession to the new Adoration Chapel and conclude with the opening of the chapel. Please plan to come, bring your family, and invite a friend.

Forty Hours is more than a series of services; it is our parish kneeling together before Jesus, really and truly present—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the Eucharist. The Mass is the “source and summit” of our Christian life; Eucharistic Adoration is its quiet extension, when the heart lingers with the Lord who remains with us. Before the monstrance, time slows, distractions fade, and the soul learns again to listen. Here we learn to love the Sacred Heart, to intercede for our families, and to place our parish under Christ’s gentle kingship.

I am especially grateful that our Forty Hours will lead us to the procession and opening of our new Adoration Chapel. My hope is simple and strong: that this chapel will become an oasis of prayer—a place of silence in a noisy world, a small Nazareth in the midst of our daily work. I pray it will be a refuge for the weary, a school of holiness for our children and youth, a lamp of intercession for the sick, the poor, and those far from the Church, and a furnace where vocations are warmed into life.

How can you take part?

- Come one evening—or all three. If you have been away from Adoration, begin again.
- Bring intentions. Write the names and needs you carry; place them before the Lord.
- Bring your family. Even brief visits teach little ones where our peace is found.
- Consider a weekly Holy Hour. As the chapel schedule is finalized, I invite parishioners to “adopt” an hour and anchor our parish in constant prayer.

A few reminders for the chapel: enter in reverent silence, silence phones, and treat the space as a sanctuary where others are praying. In that quiet, the Lord does His best work: He consoles, heals, and strengthens; He speaks to the heart.

Thank you to all who have prayed, given, and labored so that this day could come. May these days of Forty Hours renew our love for the Eucharist and kindle a deeper devotion that will sustain our parish for years to come.

Let us meet the Lord together this week—7:00 PM Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday—and then carry the flame of His Presence into every corner of our lives.

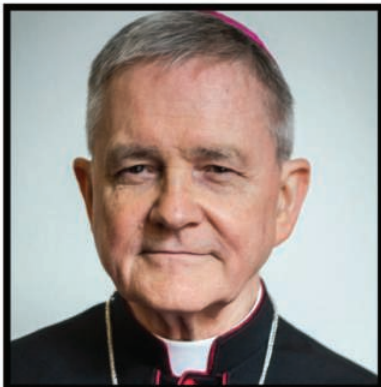

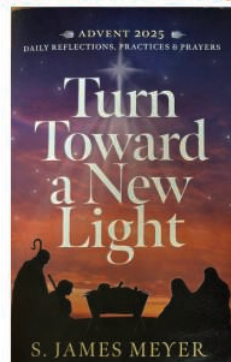

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month. Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
