From Father:

In this Sunday's Gospel, we witness a poignant exchange between the Risen Christ and Simon Peter. After sharing a meal by the Sea of Galilee, Jesus asks Peter three times, "Do you love me?" Each time Peter affirms his love, Jesus responds with a commission: "Feed my lambs," "Tend my sheep," "Feed my sheep."

This dialogue serves as a profound moment of restoration and commissioning. Peter, who had denied Jesus three times during the Passion, is now given the opportunity to reaffirm his love and commitment. Jesus entrusts him with the care of His flock, emphasizing that love for Christ must be the foundation of pastoral ministry.

As our Church prepares for the upcoming conclave to elect a new pope, we are reminded of the immense responsibility entrusted to the cardinal electors. To support them in this sacred task, our parish is launching the Adopt a Cardinal program this weekend. At the exits of the Church, you will find cards, each bearing the name of a cardinal under the age of 80 who will participate in the conclave.

I encourage each of you to take a card and commit to praying for that cardinal—not that he be elected pope, but that he be enlightened by the Holy Spirit and have the courage to follow the Spirit's guidance in electing a new pope. Let us pray fervently for a successor to St. Peter who will boldly proclaim Christ to the world and remain steadfast in the faith handed down from the Apostles.

May our prayers, like Peter's reaffirmation of love, contribute to the strengthening of our Church's leadership and mission.

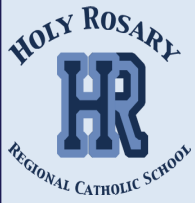

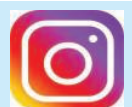

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
