From Father:

This week you'll receive my annual Stewardship Appeal letter. Each fall I ask every household to pray, reflect, and make (or renew) a yearly commitment of time, talent, and treasure. Stewardship isn't just "fund-raising"; it's the Gospel pattern of gratitude—recognizing that everything we have is a gift. Your generosity keeps our parish vibrant: forming our children in the faith, caring for the poor, celebrating the Sacraments with beauty, maintaining our campus, and launching new evangelizing initiatives.

This year's appeal is joyfully linked to a milestone for our parish family: the opening of our new Adoration Chapel. Mark your calendars—our chapel is scheduled to open on **Tuesday, November 11**, at the close of our **Forty Hours Eucharistic Devotions**, with a dedication by **Archbishop Adams**. What a grace to anchor our parish life around the Eucharistic Lord in a dedicated place of silence, reverence, and encounter. My hope is that the chapel becomes the beating heart of Epiphany—a place where burdens are laid down, vocations are discerned, families are strengthened, and the Lord's mercy is received.

Many have asked how they can help bring the chapel to completion. Along with your regular stewardship commitment, we have different **memorialization opportunities** for those who would like to honor a loved one or give a special gift. Items available for memorials include principal furnishings and sacred art for the chapel (for example: altar, tabernacle, sanctuary lamp, windows, and statues). If you're interested, please reach out to the parish office; we'll be happy to share details.

To help you visualize the project, please see pages 6 and 7 of this bulletin and there is a **poster board with photos and renderings of the chapel** and its appointments **in the back of the church**. Please take a look after Mass. You'll see how thoughtfully the space has been designed for prayer—simple, beautiful, and unmistakably oriented to Jesus in the Eucharist. Also, please check out our website **epiphanyoffourlord.com** to see photos and videos of the renovation that has been work done on the chapel.

Thank you for the countless ways you already give—quietly, faithfully, and sacrificially. Together, let's take this next step as a parish family: deepening our Eucharistic love and making sure the mission of Epiphany is strong for our children and for those the Lord is still drawing home.

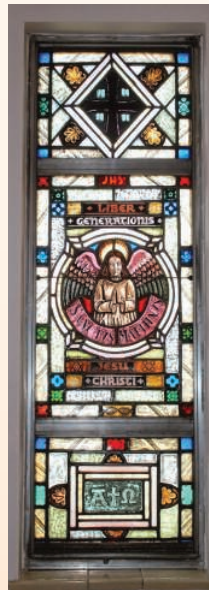

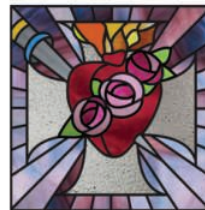

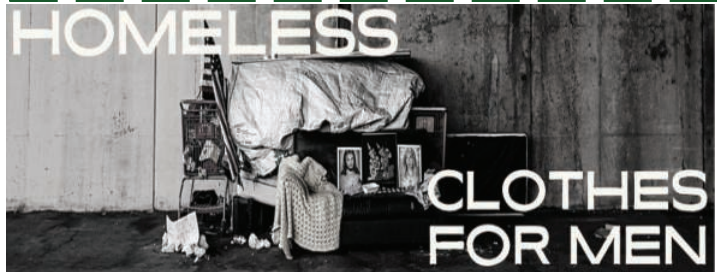

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month. Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
