

The next meeting Nourish for Caregivers is on **Wednesday, Jul. 16** at 1:30pm in the church narthex of Epiphany of Our Lord Church. The topic of discussion will be *Staying Engaged -Keeping Them Engaged*.

From Father:

This Sunday we celebrate two giants of the early Church—Saint Peter and Saint Paul—pillars of our faith whose witness continues to shape the life of the Church today. Though very different in background, temperament, and mission, they were united by one thing: their total surrender to Jesus Christ.

Peter was a fisherman, impetuous and often unsure, yet chosen by Christ to be the visible head of the Church. To him was given the keys to the Kingdom, and despite his denials during the Passion, Peter was restored by the mercy of the Risen Lord. He became a bold shepherd, laying down his life in Rome by crucifixion, faithful to the end.

Paul, by contrast, was a Pharisee, well-educated and zealous for the Law. Initially a persecutor of Christians, he encountered the risen Christ on the road to Damascus and was utterly transformed. He became the Church's greatest missionary, proclaiming the Gospel to the Gentiles and enduring hardships, imprisonments, and finally martyrdom by the sword, also in Rome.

Together, Peter and Paul remind us that Christ calls all types of people into His service: the weak and the strong, the impulsive and the intellectual, the repentant sinner and the passionate believer. What unites them is not their perfection, but their fidelity to Christ and their willingness to be poured out for the sake of the Gospel.

Their feast reminds us of our own vocation to build up the Church today, in our time and place. Like Peter, we are called to stand firm in the truth of the faith. Like Paul, we are sent to bring that truth to the world. Both tasks require courage. Both require grace.

May Saints Peter and Paul pray for us and for the whole Church, that we may remain steadfast in faith and fervent in mission.

Saint Peter, rock of the Church, pray for us.

Saint Paul, Apostle to the Gentiles, pray for us.

Missionary Giving Weekend

This weekend—Pray and help support the Carmelite of Mary Immaculate who brings the Gospel message of Jesus and serves the poor and needy in a Mission Land.

CMI missionaries are present significantly in South America (Peru, Ecuador, Paraguay, Argentina, and Brazil) and in Africa (Kenya, Madagascar, Namibia, Ghana, South Africa, and Tanzania). 120 priests are serving in the USA, Canada and more than that number throughout Europe. The mission in Nepal, although quite recent, is a vigorous and upcoming apostolic field. The Congregation has its presence in more than 30 countries.

Your contribution will go a long way in supporting the missions in Africa and Latin America and a large number of seminarians. Your prayers and financial support will sustain them in their vocation and they will be equipped to serve the universal church with ample resources and competence.

The average monthly expense of a seminarian is about \$100 per month (in India) and in Africa almost doubles the amount. A pre-owned vehicle in Africa costs about \$17,000 to 24,000 in Africa and South America. A tube well (Bore well) costs \$7,000 to 10,000.

Your generosity will be greatly appreciated by the people and the missionaries.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.


