## From Father:

*This weekend, we mark the Fourth Sunday of Lent, known as Laetare Sunday—a special moment in our Lenten journey when the Church invites us to pause and rejoice. "Laetare" is Latin for "rejoice," taken from the entrance antiphon, "Rejoice, Jerusalem..." On this day, the somber tones of Lent lighten slightly, reflected in the rose-colored vestments worn by priests, symbolizing joy amidst penance.*

*Laetare Sunday reminds us that even in times of penance, hardship, and self-denial, we have profound reasons to celebrate: our redemption draws near! Lent is not merely a season of sacrifice or deprivation; it is a journey toward renewal, transformation, and a closer relationship with Christ. The discipline and sacrifices of Lent can often bring discomfort, yet they are not ends in themselves. Instead, they help open our hearts and minds to a deeper joy—a joy rooted not in temporary happiness, but in the enduring presence and love of God.*

*In the midst of suffering, trials, or difficulties, this joy does not diminish; it strengthens us. It reminds us that God's grace is sufficient even in our weakness, and that He journeys with us every step of the way. This joy reassures us of Christ's victory over sin and death, bringing meaning and purpose to our sacrifices and challenges.*

*As we continue our journey toward Easter, let this Sunday's joyful spirit encourage us to renew our commitment to Christ, to embrace both our struggles and triumphs with faith. Rejoice because the victory of love over sin, life over death, is drawing near.*

*May we embrace the remaining days of Lent with hope, trust, and joyful anticipation, knowing the Resurrection awaits us!*

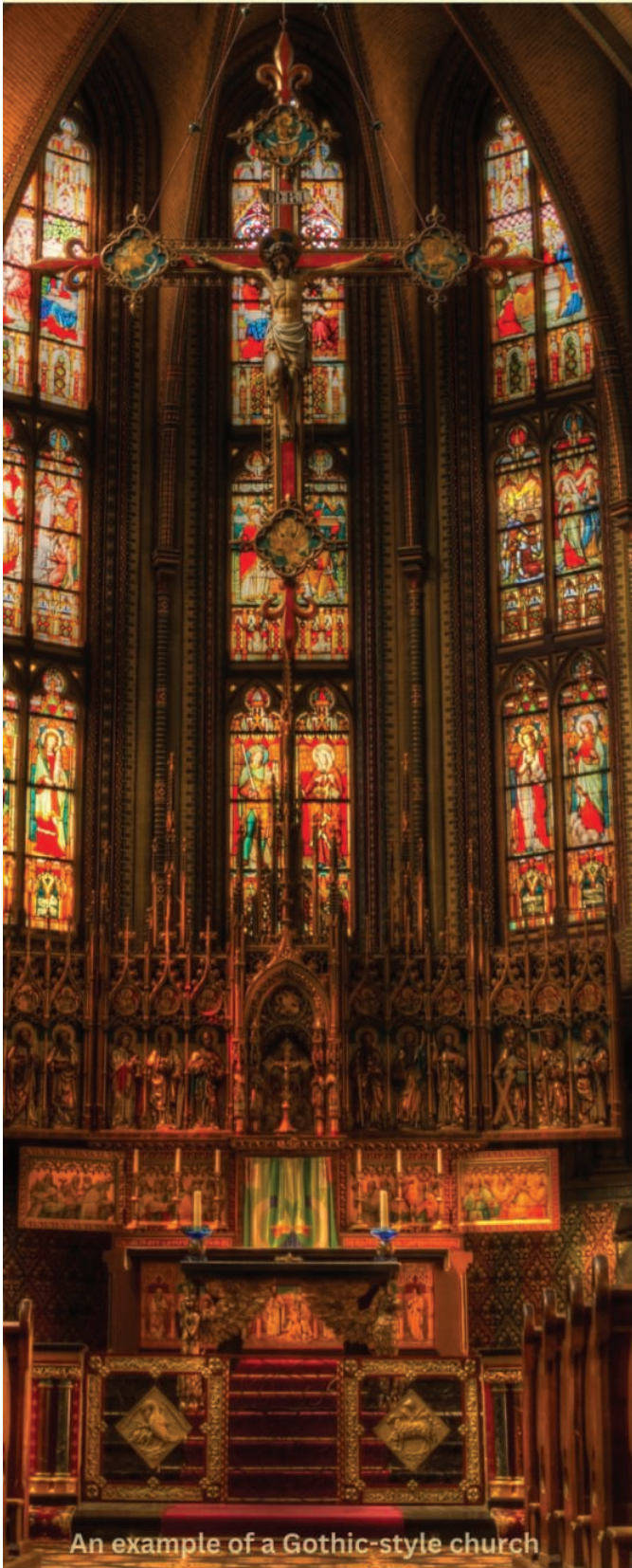
