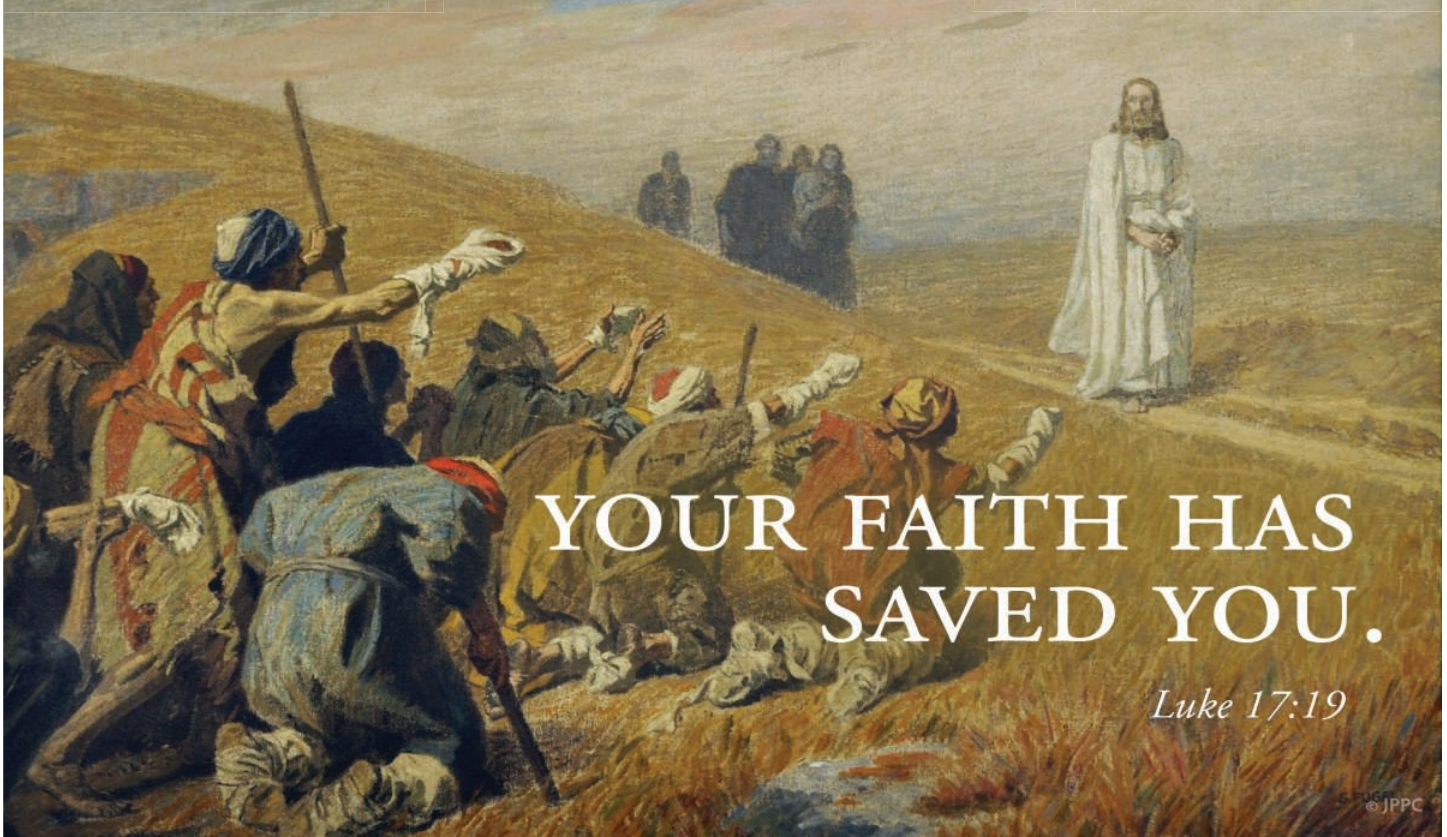

From Father:

On the road to Jerusalem, ten lepers cry out from a distance: "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" The Lord sees them, sends them to the priests, and on the way they are cleansed. But only one turns back, a Samaritan. He falls at Jesus' feet and gives thanks. To him, Jesus says something more than "You are healed." He says, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you."

Gratitude is not a minor courtesy in the Christian life; it is the doorway to deeper communion with God. All ten receive a gift, but only the grateful one finds the Giver. He returns, he worships, and in that act of thanksgiving he receives not only restored skin but a restored heart. The Lord's final word—"saved"—reveals that gratitude ushers us from mere benefit to living relationship.

Today's first reading (Naaman the Syrian) forms a beautiful pair with the Gospel. Naaman is healed of leprosy and then returns to Elisha, confessing the true God and offering thanks. Blessings rightly lead us back to the One from whom they come. When they do not, something in us remains unhealed—even if our circumstances improve. Ingratitude is a kind of spiritual leprosy: it numbs the heart, isolates us from God and neighbor, and disfigures our vision until we see gifts as entitlements.

The Church trains our hearts in gratitude at every Mass. "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God." "It is right and just." The very word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving. Each Sunday we are like the Samaritan who returns: we come back to fall at Jesus' feet, to acknowledge the mercy we have received, and to be sent out again, not merely helped but saved. If you ever wonder what you "get" out of Mass, begin here: you are formed into a grateful disciple, and gratitude reorders everything.

How do we cultivate this virtue?

1. Name your gifts. Each evening, take two minutes to name three blessings from the day—large or small—and thank the Lord for each. This simple habit softens the heart and opens the eyes.

2. Return to the Giver. When God answers a prayer or grants a favor, mark it. Light a candle before the tabernacle, say a decade of the Rosary in thanksgiving, write a note to someone who was an instrument of grace.

3. Thank before you ask. Bring your petitions, but begin with praise. Gratitude is not blindness to suffering; it is the decision to see God first, even in the cross. Christ does not eliminate pain; He gives it depth and meaning by His presence.

4. Confess ingratitude. If resentment, envy, or complaint has taken root, bring it to Confession. The Sacrament of Penance is spiritual medicine for a thankless heart. God delights to cleanse us, not once, but again and again.

Notice, too, the humility of the grateful leper. He falls at Jesus' feet. Gratitude and humility are siblings: the humble person can receive because he knows he is not the source of his own life. Pride, by contrast, collects gifts without bowing. A parish filled with grateful, humble disciples becomes a place of joy. Grateful hearts become generous hands—at home, at work, and in our parish family.

This week, let us imitate the Samaritan. Return to the Lord. Thank Him for mercies already given—health restored, sins forgiven, friendships sustained, daily bread provided, faith preserved. Thank Him, too, for the crosses that purify our love. And then hear Him speak that deeper word to you: not only “You are helped,” but “Your faith has saved you.”

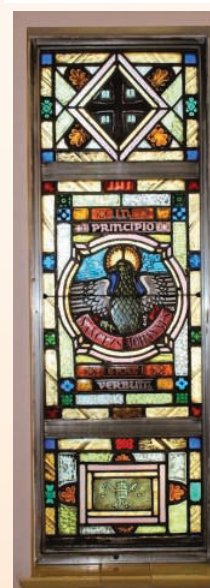

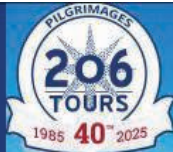
