From Father:

This year, I had the great joy of traveling with several parishioners to Sciacca, a beautiful coastal town in southern Sicily, for the annual Feast of Madonna del Soccorso. For many of our parishioners, Sciacca is not just a distant place; it is a part of their heritage and their hearts. This will be my third time attending the feast, and each visit has left me deeply inspired by the faith and devotion of the people who gather to honor our Blessed Mother under this special title.

The devotion to Madonna del Soccorso dates back centuries, beginning with Saint Augustine, who relied on Mary's intercession as he turned away from a life of sin. This devotion deepened over time, especially in 1306, when Father Nicolo Bruno, a friar suffering from terminal illness, experienced a miraculous healing after invoking her intercession. The powerful image of Mary as a protector, crushing the devil beneath her feet, has become a source of hope and strength for countless faithful.

In the 1500s, Saint Augustine's friars brought the devotion to Sciacca, where it flourished. The people commissioned a statue of the Madonna del Soccorso, depicting Mary with a club in hand, ready to defeat evil. This statue, lovingly cared for by the fishermen of Sciacca, has been carried in procession through the streets for over 500 years. The tradition began during a devastating plague in 1626 when the people of Sciacca prayed fervently to the Madonna. Her intercession brought a miraculous end to the pestilence, filling the streets with the fragrance of incense and hope.

This devotion has crossed oceans and generations, binding together those of Sciacca and their descendants here in our parish community. It is a testament to the enduring power of faith and the comfort we find in our Blessed Mother's care. For some, participating in this feast is a way to honor their family's heritage and promises made to parents and grandparents. For others, it is a deep personal devotion to Mary, who intercedes for us in our battles against sin and despair.

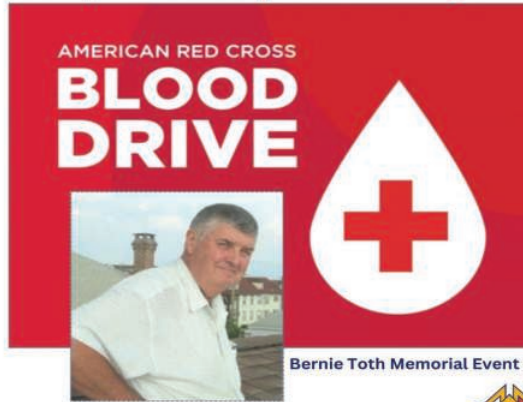
The Feast of Madonna del Soccorso reminds us that, even in times of great trial, we are never alone. Mary, our mother, walks with us, ready to aid us in our struggles and point us toward her Son, Jesus. Her intercession is a call to trust in God's power to transform our lives, even in the face of life's most challenging moments.

As we celebrate this feast, whether in Sciacca or here at home, let us remember the power of Mary's intercession and the strength of our shared faith. May the story of Madonna del Soccorso inspire us to turn to Mary in our own times of need and trust that, with her help, God's grace will triumph in our lives.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office, Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.

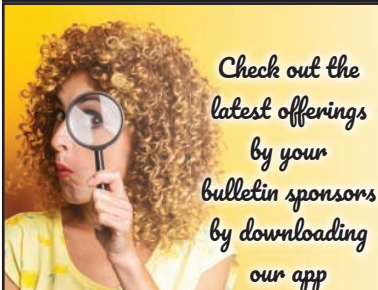
