Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Guardian Angel Prayer (aka Angel of God)

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love entrusts me here. Ever this day be at my side to light, to guard to rule and guide. Amen.

Act of Contrition

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended thee, and I detest all my sins because of thy punishments, but most of all because they offend thee, my God, Who are all good and worthy of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

Rite of First Penance

Priest: Welcomes the penitent.

Penitent: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

(make the sign of the Cross).

Priest: Invites the penitent to have trust in God. The priest or penitent may read a text of

Holy Scripture.

Penitent: Bless me Father, this is my first confession. These are my sins:

Tell the priest your sins with honesty and sorrow, and also tell the priest a little

about yourself. The priest will listen to you and guide you.

Penitent: I am sorry for these and all my sins.

The priest will give you a penance to help make up for your sins and to change

your heart.

Penitent: Act of Contrition

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended thee, and I detest all my sins because of thy punishments, but most of all because they offend thee, my God, who are all good and worthy of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin.

Amen.

After the Act of Contrition, the priest will give you Absolution.

Penitent: At the end of the Absolution say Amen (make the sign of the cross).

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.

Penitent: His mercy endures forever.
Priest: Dismisses the penitent in peace.
