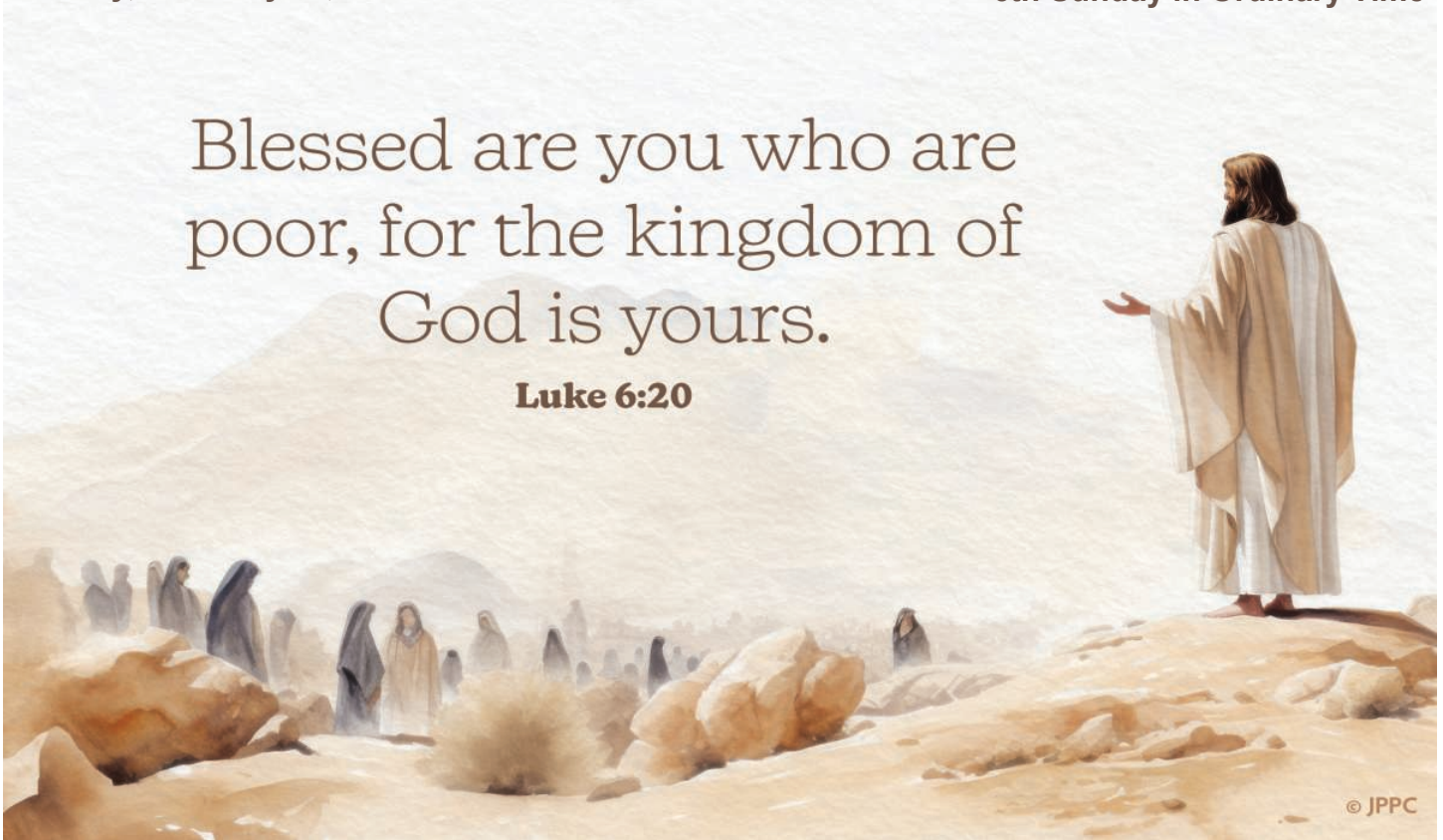

From Father:

This week, many hearts will turn to Valentine's Day—a day often filled with flowers, chocolates, and expressions of love. While much of the world sees February 14 as a celebration of romantic love, its origins point us to something deeper, rooted in faith and sacrifice.

Saint Valentine, a priest in third-century Rome, is remembered for his courage and fidelity to Christ. In a time of persecution, Saint Valentine ministered to Christians and is said to have performed weddings in secret, defying the emperor's ban on marriage for young men. His unwavering witness to God's love ultimately led to his martyrdom. What a profound reminder that love, at its core, is a gift from God—one that often calls us to give of ourselves for the good of others.

In the Catholic Christian understanding, romantic love is more than fleeting emotion or sentiment. It is a vocation—a call to live out God's love through mutual self-gift and sacrifice. True love mirrors Christ's love for the Church: selfless, faithful, and life-giving. For those called to marriage, this love becomes a reflection of God's covenant, sanctifying both husband and wife as they journey together toward holiness.

On Valentine's Day, while it's natural to celebrate with gifts and kind gestures, let us also take a moment to reflect on the deeper meaning of love in our lives. How do we express God's love to others—not only to our spouses, families, and friends but also to those who are lonely or in need? Real love seeks the good of the beloved, and sometimes that means listening, forgiving, and showing patience in moments of difficulty.

Saint Valentine's life teaches us that love is courageous and rooted in Christ. Let's pray for all married couples, those discerning marriage, and those who may be waiting for their vocation. May they always find strength and inspiration in God's boundless love.

And whether we're single, married, or in religious life, we can all take part in sharing Christ's love with the world around us. That is the true heart of Saint Valentine's legacy.

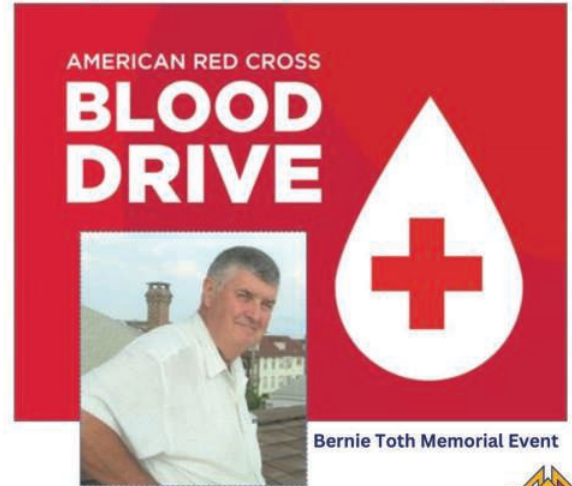

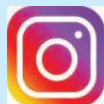

CLOSING INFORMATION

- Our parish follows the lead of the Colonial School District with regard to weekday Mass and the delayed opening/closing of the parish office due to inclement weather.
- When Colonial has a two-hour delay, or closes, our 8:30 a.m. weekday Mass will be cancelled, and the Mass intention will be celebrated privately by the priest.
- In the event of a Colonial School District two-hour delay, the parish office and chapel will open two hours late.
- If Colonial is closed, the parish office and chapel are closed. Scheduled meetings will be canceled unless otherwise notified.
- If you have questions or need help rescheduling appointments or meetings you can call the parish office when we return. Or if it's an emergency, please call Father O'Donald.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
